


# **EMERGENZA SENEGAL**

In the 1970s and 1980s years of last century, a devastating drought has invaded the Sahel, leading to the loss of agriculture and water resources, whose social consequences were more than a million deaths and 50 million people in famine. Today, in the region of Sedhiou, Senegal, drought has totally changed the ecosystem of the river Casamance and its tributaries, causing the loss of thousands hectares of potentially arable land, contamination of wells and thus poverty.

In Sedhiou, 80,000 people today risk their lives because of the devastating effects of the drought, which has brought with it death and poverty.

## Why a "bridge" for life?

As a result of the drought, the flood tides from the Atlantic Ocean run up the river Casamance, making its 5 times saltier than the sea, flooding farmland and contaminating water wells. The no profit organization Balouo Salo intends to implement the project of a bridge-dam in the valley of Tanaff, that will makes 10,000 hectares of land fertile. The dam will allow the decontamination of water in wells and will promote agriculture for the benefit of 80,000 people in 350 villages.

#### Where?

The project will be implemented in the region of Sedhiou, in Senegal, in the valley of Tanaff, whose basin is 480 square kilometers.

#### Whos

The project will be carried out by volunteers of the no profit organization Balouo Salo, along with 20.000 people of the villages beneficiaries, and with the collaboration of municipalities, technical services in the region, and the government of Senegal.









#### The objectives

The main objective is to solve, in a sustainable way, the humanitarian emergency in Senegal, with a model project which could be reproducible in other nearby areas. The volunteers, professionals, partners and supporters of the project, who are involved in the project, share principles of the no profit organization and intend to make their contribution to address all of the issues of the place.

The project will be adopted at national level for the recovery of many other valleys of Casamance, allowing a significant development process of the country and promoting the welfare of the population.

The project wants to bring a solution for the problems, fundamental to the lives of beneficiaries. The project will:

- Bring down malnutrition in 350 villages;
- Restore 10,000 hectares of land for agricultural production;
- Offer new opportunity for 40,000 people to work;
- Decontaminate and desalinate the aquifer and water wells.

#### Our intervention

Thanks to the model developed, the objective will be achieved with a single, sustainable, economical and durable intervention, deployed by the cooperation with local and international authorities. The implication of all parties will allow the construction of the dam.

#### **Expected Results**

The bridge dam will allow the recovery of 10 thousand hectares of cultivable land during the first two years, with a progressive recovery, up to a maximum of 15,000 hectares.

The results from the project will be:

- -the lowering of malnutrition and infant mortality;
- -the improvement of water quality;
- -the improvement of health conditions;
- -the improvement in economic conditions.

### **Budget**

Our non-profit organization has been using the "ALL TO DONATE" principle. All of donations received is allocated to the project, totally. The proceeds will not be used for administrative costs, travel or anything else which are, instead, borne by the individual volunteer or board. No component of the association receives awards or compensation of any kind. With this system the association promises to quickly reach the necessary budget to the project, with the support of local authorities in order to achieve a true work of cooperation.
